

Facts about Incentive Pay

April 17, 2007

- Nearly \$100 million in incentive pay grants have already been awarded to more than 1,100 campuses for the *current* school year.
- In addition, 1,132 campuses have already been identified to receive \$100 million in grants in the 2007-08 school year. In total, more than \$580 million will be awarded over the biennium.
- Below is a small sample of the districts that have already been awarded incentive pay—and whose excellent teachers will receive a **pay cut** if the incentive pay program is repealed:
